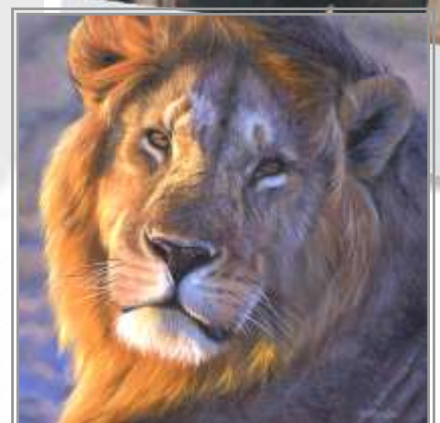
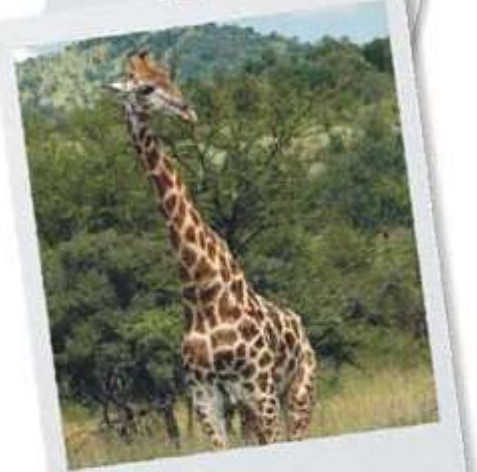
What is not included?

Pilanesberg National Park Safari's

Often being called "The Volcano that gave birth to a game reserve", this park is situated on the remains of a volcanic crater, said to be one of the only three alkaline volcanoes in the world. It is estimated that the eruptions took place some 1,300 million years ago, leaving behind a unique geological structure.

Evidence of some rare rock types, such as foyaites and syenites make up many of the rocky structures, these hard rocks are found many kilometers under the earth crust and were brought to the surface and deposited by the volcano. At the time of the volcanic activity, the height of the volcanic mountains were estimated to be about 7,000 meters above the earth's surface, today they have weathered to no more than 700 meters.

The Pilanesberg Park was conceived in 1969. It took ten years of research before it finally opened on 8 December 1979.

Firstly, this 55,000 hectare had to be prepared, by removing all evidence of mechanized farming and mining. Houses, fences, windmills, pumps and mining equipment were dismantled and trucked away. Tons of alien vegetation were removed and indigenous vegetation was seeded in its place. The eroded land had to be reclaimed and the area had to be fenced.

Pilanesberg Tours

Day 1

- Collection from OR Tambo Airport (JHB) or any destination within the Greater Johannesburg/Pretoria area.
- Time permitting we will do a morning game drive in the Pilanesberg before returning to check into our Luxury Lodge.
- Lunch at our Luxury Lodge in the Pilanesberg.
- Open vehicle game drive – this game drive begins around 16h30 in summer, and the tour lasts about 3 hours. Nocturnal game that we often see on this drive includes Porcupine, Honey Badger, Bush Baby, Water mongoose and Giant Spotted Owls.
- We return to our Lodge, freshen up and have Dinner.

Day 2

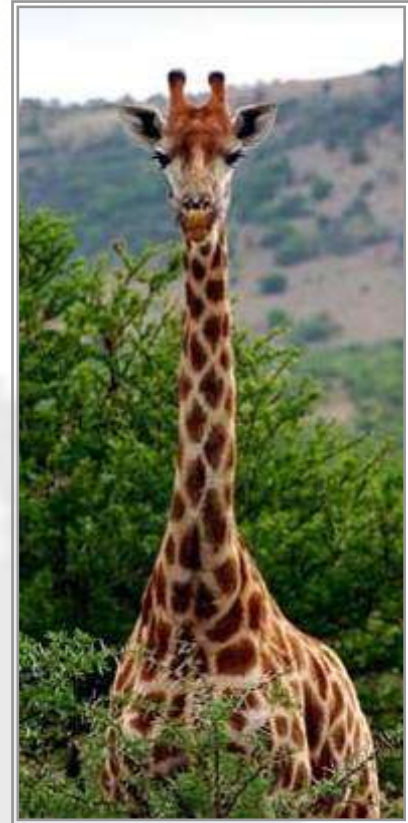
- 05h00. Wake up call. Sunrise tea, coffee & biscuits
- 05h30. Our early morning open vehicle game drive begins.
- 08h30. We return to our lodge for breakfast.
- We check out of our Lodge.
- Depending on the programme, we either return to the Pilanesberg and continue our safari or indulge in the many other activities that there are on offer.
- A luncheon stop is planned.
- At the end of the afternoon we head back to Johannesburg, and we drop you off at your requested destination.

Alpetra Nature Reserve

Alpetra Nature Reserve is located in the Limpopo province, between Vaalwater and Lephalale (formerly Ellisras) in the Waterberg area, the very heart of the Limpopo bushveld region.

The reserve is located on 3600Ha of privately owned land which also hosts a number of wild animals namely Buffalo, Kudu, Impala, Eland, Zebra, Red Hartebeest, Waterbuck, Gemsbuck, Blue Wildebeest, baboons, leopards and many other smaller antelope.

A large area around the lodge is completely safe and very beautiful to enjoy daily bush walks at your own leisure. No dangerous animals roam around these parts, but you might come across some Nyala, Kudu, Waterbuck or even Bushbuck and Blue Wildebeest along the way.

Cool down after a game drive in the African bush, by enjoying the sparkling blue pool underneath a beautiful, age-old wild fig tree. Enjoy late afternoon sundowners or an early evening BBQ at the big and fully equipped lapa, while watching the sun go down over the beautiful dam at the end of the luscious lawns at the heart of the lodge

Roodekrans Game Reserve

We have a property within the Roodekrans Game Reserve which is a privately owned reserve. The Reserve is close to Lanseria Airport and falls under the Renosterspruit Conservancy.

On the property there swimming pool that is under renovation and there is an outside lapa. The house is fully fenced with an electric fence.

The property is best accessed by a 4x4 vehicle. No low vehicles, as there is a section that is rocky.

We are situated in the cradle of Humankind, close to Hartebeespoort Dam and the Lion Park.

There are over 300 species of birds, 21 species of buck, (Including Kudu) and a family of giraffe within the reserve. This property is truly unique, being in the heart of the bush-veld, yet close to the city.
